#11 Xclusive showed no mercy in the annihilation of #13 Pocket Sniper **11-0** registering their best game so far this conference in this hot and sticky Friday in Round 7 of the 52nd DFBC All Filipino Bowling League, 2017 2nd Conference supported by BEFIT-AKI Fitness.

The Brown Adonis, Boni Manalang was the star for Xclusive as he pounced their opponent no end en route to his record breaking 712 series on games of 261, 204 & 247. Boni erased the 706 record of Ramil Aquino with his relentless attacks. Assisting Boni was their Team Captain Albert Leyesa who showed that there is still some juice left adding 683 series on games of 221, 245 & 217, former Kilabot ng mga Kolehiyala now a father, Walter Aldeguer who made mincemeat of the difficult lane condition amassing 681 series on games of 217, 201 & 263, Lily Leyesa was almost there with 594 series and Louie Sindayen who end the scoring with 562 series. Xclusive broke the 3,201 Team High Game Series with Handicap of Team Pilipinas with their 3,232 series and Sherlock 2,844 Team High Game Scratch record with their 2,872 series. They have booked as well DCC Cargo Team of the Week honors on their effort. Xclusive pushed themselves inside The Elite Top 10 teams at #8 with 38 points.

Pocket Sniper was paced by Leo Lerma with 642 series, Doods Salazar with 629 series, Billy Hernandez with 592 series and Lucy Idiente (306) combined with Cecel (81) for 387 series. Pocket Sniper moved down to #16 with 26 points.

#7 Tweeners destroyed #1 Sherlock **7-2**. It was lady power who carried the team to victory led by Tess Victoria who was sizzling with 647 series on games of 227, 209 & 211. The heavy duty Jonner Miranda smashed the pins with 626 series leading the TBS guys notwithstanding the presence of his UmUm on the other side of the fence.
