#15 IIEE showed their true worth in thrashing #14 Wild Wild X **11-0** in this adrenaline-charged Friday in Round 11 of the 52nd DFBC All Filipino Bowling League, 2017 2nd Conference supported by BEFIT-AKI Fitness.

It was all business for the Electrical Engineers as they electrocuted their opponents to establish the lopsided victory. Bernard Solomon showed them how easy the lane condition is as he established a career high 671 series on games of 227, 224 & 220. Very steady games from little known Bernard as he is trying to make his presence felt with his impeccable bowling. Bernard received compliments from the high flying monkey eating eagle of DFBC, Liza Lugto who chopped 655 series on games of 229, 200 & 226, Loreto Gonzaga was a revelation with his 611 series, Arnel Arias came through with 592 series and Isagani Porcina (390) joined forces with Joven (209) for 599 series. IIEE total team series of 3,128 pin falls was the highest recorded for the day allowing them to romp away with DCC Cargo Team of the Week award. IIEE made a huge jump from #15 inside The Elite Top 10 teams at #8 with their total of 53 points.

Wild Wild X was paced by Rodel Calderon (603), Obet Lucero (581), Sharon Cosio (522), Ron (500) and Team Captain Sonny Cosio (374) who bolted with Mariz Santiago (187) for 561 series. Wild Wild X is at #16 with 44 points.

#2 Tweeners sacked #8 DCC Cargo **8-2**. Tweeners enjoying one of their best season was directed by new recruit Tess Victoria who was sizzling with 657 series winning Ballantine's High Series of the Week award. Assisting Tess in their win were Robi "Patira" Gamboa who slurped 604 series which is the same score submitted by Team Captain Kathleen "Peachy" Raymundo, The Black Superman, Xanthie "Doc" Fronda followed with 564 series with Doc Ronnie Fabian closed the scoring for the team with 550 series. Tweeners continue to hold the #2 spot with their total of 70 points.

Jake was aided by high flyer Larry Dolor who procured 621 series, Team Captain Edgar Ramos who produced 606 series, Stephen Fideles who formed 579 series and Tina Tabon who fashioned 569 series. Sherlock stayed at #4 with 65 points.
