#10 Xclusive massacred #9 DCC Cargo **10-0** in this exciting Friday in Round 12 of the 52nd DFBC All Filipino Bowling League, 2017 2nd Conference supported by BEFIT-AKI Fitness.

Xclusive made up for their lackluster performance in Round 11 with an eye popping game as they took turns in beating the lights out against DCC Cargo. It was perfect combination for Team Captain Albert Leyesa who watched from the sidelines how the team complimented each other in registering the win. Myra Aviles played like there is no tomorrow in recording 673 series winning Ballantine's High Series of the Week award. Helping Myra were Manny Lacuanan who was instrumental in achieving their 2 bonus points in the final game provided 659 series, Lily Leyesa inspiringly contributed 622 series, Ryan Inigo managed to get to 600 with his 602 series which allows The Black Adonis, Boni Manalang to gallivant with 545 series while his team mates slaughtered their opponent. Xclusive total Team Pin falls of 3,101 was the highest for the day winning DCC Cargo Team of the Week award. In addition, the team took a big jump from #10 to #6 in the team standings with their total of 62 points.

DCC Cargo was paced by Danny Casio with 613, Team Captain Tracyval Cada with 594, Al Casio with 556, Merle Pilapil Cada with 469 and Arnel Bernas (146) joined forces with Lukas Sta. Barbara (442) for 588. DCC Cargo was kicked out of The Elite Top 10 teams at #13 with 53 points.

Doc Fabian was ably aided by Tess Victoria who corroborated 641 series highlighted by her 266 high game in game 2 winning Dante's Peak Bowler of the Week award, Robi "Patira" Gamboa welcome the team with 616 series, Team Captain Kathleen Raymundo who substantiated 558 series and The Black Superman, Xanthie Fronda finished the scoring with 509 series. Tweeners win allowed them to cut the lead of the #1 team from 10 to 6 as they stay at #2 with 80 points.

#17 Pocket Sniper came out victorious on their battle with #15 Team Barangay **6-2**. Aiza Garcia showing she is not only beauty but also steady submitted 608 series to lead the team.
