

RAK Pocket Sniper Pummels DBC's Pride, Wins DCC Cargo Team of the Week, On Final Round 17, 1st
Conference of DFBC 53rd All Filipino Bowling League Supported by BeFit-AKI Fitness!!!

Huli man daw at magaling, naihabol din. As if taking cue from this old Filipino proverb, the Snipers showed to all and sundry and especially to DBC's Pride, what they are capable of doing when they are clicking and running on all engines. Fielding their strongest line-up and celebrating the return of Team Captain Richie Villarosa, the Snipers encountered a big roadblock as DBC's Pride coasted to an easy first game win with a bonus to boot. The flame ignited, the Snipers who had been taking blows from opponents in the previous weeks, left and right, turned a switch on. The DBC's Pride quintet now playing cool and relax, again started 2nd game easily gobbling down the 2 marks handicap lead of the Snipers up to the 3rd frame, when all of a sudden, in the 4th frame, things started to heat up for the Snipers. 4 Snipers suddenly had a turkey or a 4 baggers each. Smelling blood, the team with a mix of veterans and upstarts continued the onslaught as the opponent wilted down to the barrage of strikes. Score after game 2: Snipers-4/DBC'S Pride-3. Game 3 started where the Snipers left off from game 2, only difference is that they only score a bonus. Final tally:Snipers-9/DBC's Pride-3. Though missing out in the top 10, the Snipers still have their pride intact and is looking forward to the 2nd Conference, with a high morale, knowing that they can come up with huge scores to bury the opponents. 4 out of 5 players of the Snipers, score above 600. Doods Salazar the DIBC Ramadan 1st R-up, boosting his confidence sky high, led his team with 663. The lefty, Leo Lerma who was a very promising bowler a few years back had he not took a leave of absence in bowling, submitted an identical 663. Lucy Ingente, an under-rated lady bowler, but a good bowler nonetheless, soft-rolls a very impressive 661, Billy Hernandez, the WTA-High Game Supremo, cross-alleyed 601 and bringing up the rear, was Captain Richie Villarosa's 533. DBC's Pride was led by Yow Rivera's 661, followed by Jo Nava's 615, Joseph Quintilan's 608, Noel Bejar's 591 and Joel Comendador's so-so 558.

Eventual and back to back Champion Tweeners, put an exclamation mark on their championship campaign when they blasted B&G 8-0, to give them a comfortable and an un-reachable lead. It was actually over, right after the 2nd game when Harimanok Farms stumbled and lost game 2, effectively ending their chase for the Championship and handing the Tweeners their 2nd Championship in the last 2 conferences. The Tweeners were themselves on the brink of losing the 1st game, but as fate would have it, they escaped with a 3 pinfalls win. The 3 games that the Tweeners won are all down the wire, close games but their nerves held and they came through. Kapitana Kathleen Raymundo led the Tweeners quintet and put order in the chaos as she cranked 607 series, Doc Ronnie Fabian who was as cool as they could get, revs-up a 602, Andy Ducado from AUH, even hired a driver to be able to regularly play in the later games of the league, contributed a 570, ala Tommy Jones cranker Jojo Mercado kept his composure and produced a 569 and Doc Xanthie Fronda, shares an equally effective game series of 562. Ging Aring (626) and Dong Corpuz (612) fought the good fight but it was not enough giving the TWEENERS the 2018, 1st Conference CHAMPION title! CONGRATULATIONS TWEENERS! The first may have been a "Tsamba" but the second one is an affirmation that truly your team belongs in the ELITE group of Champions. Good job!

An exciting game was brewing on lanes 5-6 between Harimanok Farms and Team Optio. For the chicken & egg farmers, it was a last ditch effort to chase the leading Tweeners, and for Optio, it was to maintain their 4th place position or even improve on it, or for both teams, it was just the sheer and exhilarating joy of extracting a win against an opponent and it does not matter who is on the other side. Harimanok, having just a small window of opportunity, quickly went to work, winning game 1, but the Optioners, with the Bowling Princess Uella Marcial in tow, struck back in game 2, winning with a wide 5 marks lead. It was practically all over but the shouting for the Farmers from that point. Chasing a 6 point deficit, they can not afford to lose one game which they did. Even if they gain a maximum of 6 points in game 3, the Tweener's were already a clear 8 points ahead, even having the luxury of losing game 3 but still come out on top. Rex Galang (would be Master's Champion in the following week) tried so hard and led the farmers in scoring, pushing a 645 series. Alvin Alfaro gave his fair share in scoring, coming up with 609 series. Seldom used, Frederick Rodriguez, put up quality minutes and quality games, for a series of 605 and Andy Erena was just there with a 585 series, but Yzay Castro struggled all game long and came up with just a 506 series. Rod who was instrumental in winning game 2 and have to be thanked for by the Tweeners, for scoring big (241) in game 2, finished with a series of 623. Alek Maculada gave out an almost 600 score of 591, but the rest was not able to support the 2, series wise (Uella scored 207 in game 2), having just an average of 532 each player.

Approach-a-bowls smashes FC bowlers 8-2. With 4 players scoring 600 plus each, there was no way the FC Bowlers could match-up. Approach-a-bowls was smoking hot in games 1 & 2, winning with a bonus each and took the series points as well, before cooling down in the 3rd game. AUH based Archie Agustin, played a heck of a game in the 1st, when he torched the lanes for a 252 for an impressive series of 663, winning for him the Male Series of the Week award. Joanne Dela Cruz was likewise devastating with her 628, but it was Arnold Asuncion, oozing with confidence rolling a 626 series, and a highlight game of 263 in the 2nd game, who won the Bowler of the Week Award. Joel P. also contributed a 602 series and Daisy Cruz was also effective with her 566. FC Bowlers on their part have Reb Esma (624), Cris Toledo (618) and Ronald Valdez (596) to thank for, for putting up a fight while Noel Benavidez and Chris Calgao struggled all game long.

Covenant for all their conference woes and disappointments, even losing their long-time resident player Hector Francia who went home to the Philippines for good, came up with a strong final round game, beating multi-titlist Ballantine's 7-2. It was the unlikely duo of Marissa Manalo and Maureen Dujali who tormented the Whiskey Drinkers no end. Marissa scored a series of 681 with a highlight game 1 score of 265. Much improved Maureen Dujali, who used to throw back-ups when she was just starting the game, now had an easy time revving up a 635 to the dismay of the opponents. Jojo Acebron, their resident Class O, who has been playing sub-par lately, but still can burn up the charts when he is in his element, put up a 591, Marlon Martinez, lofts a 597, and ala Jason Belmonte, Jun Baloloy (notice the name initials), double handed a 570. On the other side, Team Captain Mario Magdaluyo, gave out a decent 598 series, Marivic Alfaro, a 582, and ADFBC President Dindo Fernando, a 568, home-sick Ricky Reyes, a 562 and Robin Edralin, longing for his partner from Gotham City, managed a mere 499.

V for Victory shut down expansion team Derdan's Strikers 8-0 and nosed out Xclusive for the 5th place (4th R-up). Benefitting from an undermanned opponent, Derdan's team. Though it was no fault of their own, but naturally, it was a walk in the park for the V for Victory squad to the dismay of the other pursuing teams. Andy Matic (Master's event 2nd R-up), who is now slowly getting back into groove, led his team with a 621 series.

DCC Cargo, riding high from the monster games of Merle Cada, up-ended Sherlock 7-2. They did not get to land a place in the top 10 but they pulled down the dog-lovers out of the Magic 10, giving the 10th position to the FC Bowlers, who were just a point ahead of Sherlock. Much improved, Merle Cada exploded for a monster 721 series in highlight game 2 score of 275, winning both the Female Bowler of the Week and High Series of the Week. Mahusay!

Elsewhere:

Xclusive scored 7-0 against a no-show Wild, Wild X, finishing 6th out of 18 teams.

The all engineers team of IIEE walloped Team Pilipinas 7-2. Liza Lugtu, flying high, led 3 players with 600 plus, scoring 642, Master's event 1st R-up, vastly improving and now, the leader of the team, Arnel Arias came up with 635, and American Boy Amboy, shells out a 607.


CONGRATULATIONS to the back to back Champion TWEENERS, and the runner-ups, Harimanok Farms, Ballantines, Optio (TBS), V for Victory, Xclusive, IIEE, B&G, DBC's Pride and FC Bowlers. CONGRATULATIONS to the MASTERS event Champion, Rex "Idol" Galang, who showed a lot of heart by coming from as low as 12th after the 5th game and scored a huge 225 in the last game to barge into the top 5, gaining the chance to play in the step-ladder shoot-out round versus, Ronald Valdez and Ryan Layoso.

Ronald started the shoot-out round with 4 baggers, versus 2 open frames of the other 2, protagonist. Ronald relaxed in the middle game, while Ryan And Rex were trying hard to catch-up. Going into the last 3 frames, Ronald stumbled and had 3 successive open frames while the 2 were trying to close the gap with their own strikes and spares. In the last frame, Ronald only had to make a spare to be unreachable for the 2, but the Gods of bowling is not on his side, for he was given a split in the last frame. Rex, who needed a punch out to squeak one over Ronald did exactly just that. Then came Ryan's turn to throw his last frame, badly needing a double-strike. He was not as lucky though, missing the pocket for just a spare. Rex then proceeded play against and beat the no 2 seed, Andy Matic, in a very close step ladder game, but missed 2 crucial spares in the last 2 frames and thus hand over the game to Idol Rex. Next, waiting in the wings was Arnel Arias, the top seed, who has a twice to beat advantage. Their game started slowly with both an open frame in the first 3 frames. Eventually, Marivic advanced to the next round to play against no. seed Tina Tabon, who played superbly and herself advanced to challenge Uella.
