#4 The Bowlers of Symmetry (TBS) found an unlikely hero in the person of Hilda Pilipina who top scored for the team in demolishing #9 IIEE **9-0** in Round 16 of DFBC 49th All Filipino Bowling League, LACOSTE Cup 2016!

Hilda was the surprise package for Team Captain Elsie Marcial as she top scored for the team with her 663 series on steady games of 219, 222 & 222. Hilda received assistance from the hard hitting Joner Miranda who smacked 646 series on games of 233, 211 & 202, 8X GCC Ladies Masters Champion and back to back WOFBT Ladies Masters Champion Uella Marcial spanked 641 scratch series on games of 200, 235 & 206, Rex "Triple XXX" Galang whacked 621 series while Joe Rodrigo closed the scoring for the team with 563 series. The Bowlers of Symmetry (TBS) total pin falls of 3,134 was the best for the day winning Edgar Vale & Nestle Team of the Week award. The win allowed them to keep their hold to #4 spot with their 99 points and a chance to the Championship trophy with 3 more rounds left.

IIEE was paced by Noel Galpo with 652 on games of 216, 209 & 227, Liza Lugto with 621, Ramil Aquino with 565, Bernard Solomon with 556 and Loreto Gonzaga with 539. IIEE stayed at #9 with 79 points.

Huge disaster struck #1 No Bandage as they were sideswiped by #7 Ballantine's **0-9**. It was Joylyn Sta. Barbara showing that she is still a force to reckon with stood as the pillar for the team's offensive against the hot streaking No Bandage. Joylyn was burning from the tip off as she ripped her opponent with 251 in the first game, followed by 244 in the second game before slowing down in the final game with 203 for 698 series. #3 LACOSTE (Dante's Peak) benefited from the incomplete #17 Remy's Team in carving out a **9-0** win. The Silent Operator, Ricky Reyes directed the plays for the team with 673 scratch series. Ricky received subsidy from ADFBC stalwart Jhey Laurel who exploded for 647 series, Clarisse Corpuz who contributed 549 series, Ramil Tesoro who struggle with 532 scratch series and Baby Face Bernard Cabantog who unwind with 530 series. LACOSTE (Dante's Peak) moved up to #2 with their 107 points.

Remy's Team was paced by Tina Tabon with 613 series on games of 202, 210 & 201, Rodel Billones with 563 and Sonny Cosio with 537. Remy's Team is at #17 with 52 points.

#5 Louie's Team crushed into pieces #18 The InKredibowls **10-0**. Joseph Quintillan teamed up with Mike Minay in destroying their opponent. Joseph tallied 677 series on games of 201, 256 & 220 while Mike downed 664 series. #15 Covenant defeated #11 V for Victory **8-2**. Marlon Martinez was the star for the team with his 639 series with help coming from the Human Twister, Hector Francia who twisted 619 series, Manny Rivala came next with 584 series, Team Captain Maria Gil (375) bolted with Luzel Martinez (201) for 576 series and Danton Abejero (338) joined hands with Cris Bucu (243) for 581 series. Covenant win put them at #14 with 69 points.

V for Victory was paced by Mike Vargas with 643, Team Captain Butch Vargas with 626, Joan Vargas with 564, Alfie de Ubago with 535 and Lilian Vargas with 540. V for Victory went down to #12 with 74 points.

#1 Xclusive took advantage of their game against themselves scoring **10** points to regain the top spot from disaster stricken No Bandage. The come backing Manny Lacuanan was the star for Xclusive as he top scored with 681 series on games of 220, 223 & 238 winning Ballantine's High Series of the Week award. Manny received a lot of support from Lily Leyesa who was also sizzling hot with her 658 series on games of 211, 214 & 233, former Kilabot ng mga Kolehiyala Walter Aldeguer provided 636 series, Boni Manalang who countered with 567 series and Team Captain Albert Leyesa who closed the scoring with 564 series. Xclusive win allowed them to overtake the #1 team as they took the #1 spot with their 109 points.

#14 B&G scored **7** points when they went up against themselves in Lanes 3&4. It was Dong Corpuz who is at the forefront of B&G offensive with 603 series with help coming from Edwin Diaz who went through with 566 series, Team Captain Herbert Capili who cut through with 563 series and Melissa Obmina who closed with 473 series. B&G amassed total of 73 points to move to #13 in the team standings.
