

Defending Champion Tweener Blasts Wild Wild X, Wins Team of the Week and Grabs the Lead in the 9th Round of the DFBC 1ST Conference, 53rd Season, All Filipino Bowling League Supported by BeFit-AKI Fitness!!!



Hindi na napigilan at kinuha na ng nagtatanggol na mga Champion na Tweeners ang liderato nang kanilang walang awang ipinagwagwagan ang nasa hulihang Wild Wild X, 9-2. Bagama't natalo sa unang laro, maski na kulang sa isang manlalaro ang katunggali, ito'y hindi naging hadlang at manapa'y nagsilbing gatong na nagpainit at nagpa-apoy sa laro ng mga Tweeners. Feeling alarmed after losing the first game, the Tweeners buckle down to work at the start of game 2 and quickly gathers momentum, earning a bonus

point and never looking back until the last frame of game 3, also winning it and this time gaining 2 bonus points for a total of 9 points. Pinangunahan ni Doc Xanthie Fronda ang opensiba ng kanyang koponan sa pagtala ng kanyang 681(196, 244 at 241) sa tatlong laro. Si Jojo Mercado naman na nanggaling pa sa malayong kapitolyo ng UAE, (Abu Dhabi) ay nagsumite ng 658 (207, 217 at 234). And as usual, the reliable Spice Girl Jaezen Plata, though starting slow, is able to finish with a 603, owing to a strong finish of 255 in game 3. Doc Ronnie Fabian is happy with his handicap maintaining 563, same with Tess Victoria who was equally satisfied with her 558. With only 4 players, the opposing side expectedly, could not keep up, and Ron Dionisio's 594, Rodel Calderon's 584, Obet Lucero's 567 and Sharon Cosio's 495, leave much to be desired.

Xclusive spoils Harimanok 6-2, goes up from no. 9 to no. 8, and pulls down, the erstwhile leader to no. 2. Thanks to the steady and solid games of Kapitan Albert Leyesa, 207, 205 and 210 for a 622 series, and the supporting games of Philip Cabutihan (571), Marivic Jorge (561) , Vice Edgar Vale (559) and Boni Manalang (558), they re-strain the favoured farmers on a closely fought game, winning game 3 by just one mark (6 pfs). While Xclusive plays steadily, the same can not be said of the Farmers. Myra Aviles' 628, and Liza Castro's 616 is worthy of mention, the boys simply wilt under the pressure and play listlessly. Xclusive, if they continue to win, still has a shot to win it all.

B&G wallops Ballantine's quintet 7-3, goes up from no. 8 to no. 7, while derailing the campaign of the Whiskey Drinkers and pulls them down to 3rd from 2nd position. 4 players fielded by Captain Herbert Capili, submits 600 plus. Leading the charge is Captain Herbert himself who shells out a 635 on scores of 209/217 and 209. B&G's own version of lady might is on show as Ging Aring who comes 2 frames late but thanks to her gritty play, still doles out 630, Babes Lopez power plays, a 611 and Grace Abalos cranks a 606. Though only Edwin Diaz is below 600 with his 576 precious pinfalls, it's worth simply can not be down played. The multi-titled Ballantine's, were not so bad themselves as 2 players are above 600. Towing them is Robin Edralin with 637, supporting him is the Silent Operator, Ricky Reyes, with 629, Captain Mario Magdaluyo is not far behind with a 580, Jun Morales is there with 576 and lady bowler Joylyn Sta. Barbara is right behind him with 568. With this win, B&G proves that when playing as a team, where everybody contributes as expected, they are hard to beat even when playing against their more heralded opponent.

V for Victory escapes IIEE 6-2 in a close contest and locks hold of position no. 5 while the Engineers fall 3 notches down from 6th to 9th position. Mike Vargas as the Alpha male on this game, submits solid games of 216/191/196 to lead the team. Supporting him is Andy Matic with 602, Abet Alba with 597, Butch Vargas with 544 and Rax Araneta with 548. V for Victory continues to hover on the top 5 and has the ability to strike at the most opportune time, when no one is taking notice. As a team with so much experience and several

championship trophies in its name, this is a team that could take the lead or the title right from the noses of the erstwhile leaders. On the other hand, IIEE may have encountered a small bump on the road, but they are still very much on track. Joven Hinampas (nang mahina) pushes his team with his 625, Gani "Ganpors" Porcina pours 597, Liza "Lawin" Lugtu flew a medium range score of 577, usually reliable Arnel Arias could only put up 554 and Christine Ocampo struggles with only a 528.

Team OPTIO picks- apart Approach-a- bowls, 6-2 on the heroics of veteran kegler Mommy Elsie Marcial. She tallies 676 (603/239/234), simply throwing strikes after strikes and converting difficult spares to the consternation of their opponents. This is easily one of her best performances so far, pulling it out, when it is so badly needed. Bowling Princess Uela Marcial slows down a bit from her past performances, but still scores a lethal 573 series. Alex Maculada, a rookie, shows off what he can do and rolls a 563, Marvin Rebusada, another rookie, holds his ground and plays a 557. Combined scores of Olan Baldivino and Vhien Datinguino of 573 are just enough to hold the fort. Approach-a-bowls' Daisy Rivera submits a very good series of 648 but nobody not named Daisy, scores respectably to support her.

In other results:



FC Bowlers scores 6-2 against Team Pilipinas on excellent performances from Capt Noel Benavidez (627) and Cris Toledo (622) and ably supported by Jomar Naguit (586), Chris Calgao (568) and Ronald Valdez (539). From the TP side, while Dennis Araza submits a team leading 623 series, and Cowboy, Caloy Serrano, a 610, the rest of the gang can only come up with an average of 550 series each.

RAK Pocket Sniper scores 6-3 versus Covenant on the strength of 600 plus games of 3 players, younglings Fuly Primo (625), and Doods Salazar (618) and muscle man Leo Lerma (606).

DBC's Pride played a friendly game with DCC Cargo with a 5-4 score in their favour. Noel Quintillan, embarrassed by his previous week's forgettable games, comes back storming on this week on scores the lights out of DIBC by posting a whopping 710 on games of 233/214 and 263 winning him the Bowler of the week award and the Series of the Week Award.

Sherlock and Derdan's Strikers scores 4 points apiece in a closely contested game. Sherlock wins 2 games but loses the series. Aileen De Leon leads all scorers with her 635, while Rica Asuncion leads all Sherlock's players with her 581.

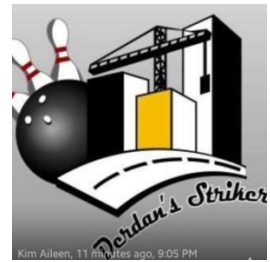
