

JAEZEN PLATA scored a rare grand slam as she erased all records leading Tweeners to the annihilation of Sherlock **8-0** in Round 10 of DFBC 51st All Filipino Bowling League 2017, 1st Conference Supported by BEFIT – AKI Fitness!!!

#3 Tweeners starring Jaezen Plata blanked #11 Sherlock **8-0** in Round 10 of the 51st DFBC All Filipino Bowling League, 2017 1st Conference supported by BEFIT-AKI Fitness.

Jaezen Plata played like there is no tomorrow as she single handedly carried her team to victory against the dangerous Sherlock team. Jaezen showed heart of steel in pounding their opponent. Scoring 249 in the first game to start the pace, she followed this up with 226 in the second game before picking up speed in the 3rd game en route to 282 (255 scratch) winning Ballantine's High Series of the Week award (757 series), Dante's Peak Bowler of the Week award (282) and Accumulator Award (255 scratch) for 7 rounds. In addition, Jaezen broke the High Game Scratch record of 244 of Ging Aring with her 255, High Game Handicap record of 279 of Ging Aring with her 282, High Series Scratch of 598 of Janice Castillo with her 676 and High Series Handicap of 718 of Janice Castillo with her 757. She also upped her average from 172.27 to 181.11 to lead High Average Class B in the female division. What a feat for Jaezen stamping her class in Round 10. Assisting Jaezen with her record breaking performance were The Black Superman, Xanthie Fronda who smashed 589 scratch series, Robi Gamboa who crushed 572 series, Team Captain Edris Sakkam who castigated 536 series and Doc Ronnie Fabian who relaxingly delivered 487 series. Tweeners managed to stay at #3 with 64 points just a stone throw away from the leaders.

Sherlock was paced by Team Captain Edgar Ramos with 619 series, Malou Fideles with 578 series, Larry Dolor with 541 series, Rodel Billones with 496 series and Gem GAnzon (336) combined with Lukas Sta. Barbara (188) for 524 series. Sherlock moved down to #16 with 38 points.

#10 IIEE massacred the hapless #9 Approach-A-Bowls **11-0**. Team effort for IIEE as they took turns in beating the lights out of Peter and team. The sexy Christine Ocampo led the charge for IIEE as she unleashed her power en route to delivering 676 series on games of 227, 211 & 238. Christine solicited support from Loreto Gonzaga who exploded for 275 in the second game on the way to 667 series winning Dante's Peak Bowler of the Week award, Liza Lugto, The Eagle of DFBC was flying high with her 657 series, Arnel Arias not to be left behind was responsible for 630 series allowing Ramil Aquino to relax with his 521 series. IIEE victory pushed them up to #7 with 51 points plus booking the DCC Cargo Team of the Week award with the team total pin falls of 3,151.

Approach-A-Bowls was paced by Joel P with 628, Daisy Rivera with 605, Albert Soriano with 551, Team Captain Peter Caguan with 547 and Ato Lubao with 531. Approach-A-Bowls fell to #12 with 43 points.

#4 Dante's Peak celebrated the return of the team's heart & soul, Team Captain cum Manager Dante Herras by beating #14 Louie's Team **8-2**. After a short break in the Philippines to observe Holy Week, President Dante is back to provide moral support to his team. The team responded despite the absence of their top bowler Ricky "The Silent Operator" Reyes as Frederick Rodriguez rose to the occasion punching 655 series. Deck as he was fondly called by his friends was supported by Ramil Tesoro who unlocked 625 series, Tina Tabon who concocted 607 series, Liza Castro who conceived 595 series and Jhey Laurel closed the scoring with 587 series. Dante's Peak win keep them at pace with the leaders as they maintained their hold to the #4 spot with 63 points.

Louie's Team was paced by Maria Macatangay (627), Janice Castillo (594), Joseph Quintillan (560), Team Captain Louie Sindayen (559) and Mike Minay (523). Louie's Team moved down to #15 with 39 points.

#1 Covenant recovered from their shocking loss in Round 9 against Team Pilipinas by blanking #16 D'Lucky Strikers **8-0**. It was Maureen Dujali's turn to lead the team as she compiled total of 606 pin falls. Maureen was complimented by Cris Bucu who assembled 600 series, The Human Twister, Hector Francia who collected 597 series, Mojo Jojo Acebron who amassed 581 series and Marlon Martinez who gathered 553 series. Covenant continues to hold on to the #1 spot with their total of 70 points.

D'Lucky Strikers was paced by Nicanor Deligente with 585, Dianne Quiambao with 522, Chaddie Quiambao with 468, Danilo Aquino with 396, Joel Umalsa with 384 and Kelly Odiong with 370. D'Lucky Strikers went down to #18 with 35 points.

#2 Team Pilipinas continue their winning run this time defeating #5 The Bowlers of Symmetry (TBS) **6-2**. Only the second team to beat the leader, Covenant, Team Pilipinas showing their win is no fluke followed this up with another win against a powerhouse team. Team Captain Dennis Araza aka John Lloyd was at the forefront of the team's attack as he led the offensive with 643 series. Dennis got ample help from Toto Agura who consumed 621 series, Round 9 hero, Rey Castillo who expended 545 series, Caloy Serrano (147) teaming up with The Towering Renato de Ramos (422) for 569 series and Sheila Estabaya (168) joined forces with Janet Jose (409) for 577 series. Team Pilipinas continue to hold on to the #2 spot with their total of 66 points.

The Bowlers of Symmetry (TBS) was paced by the come backing Olan Baldivino with 608 series, Jonner Miranda with 580 series, Uella Marcial with 574 series, Abby Rabago with 574 series and Ryan Layoso (385) combining with Team Captain Elsie Marcial (186) for 571 series. The Bowlers of Symmetry (TBS) moved to #6 with 55 points.

#6 Ballantine's escaped with a close win versus #7 FC Bowlers **6-2**. It was Team Captain Mario Magdaluyo playing an unfamiliar role of being a hero in registering the win in the 3rd game and taking the overall with his timely hits. He led the team with 663 series on games of 235, 205 & 223. Mario was assisted by Joylyn Sta. Barbara who's punched out in the final game help their cause, she finished with 626 series, RJ Calderon used his handicap to the hilt in delivering 610 series, Marivic Alfaro was also there with her 609 series allowing regular hero Jay-R Yjares to gallivant with 502 series. B&G win elevated them in The Elite Top 10 teams at #10 with 44 points.

Pocket Sniper was paced by Hashim Guinomla with 668 scratch series on games of 222, 202 & 244 winning Ballantine's High Series of the Week award, Leo Lerma with 563 series, Doods Salazar with 552 series, Raul Cariaga with 468 scratch series and Cecel with 455 series. Pocket Sniper fell to #9 with 45 points.

#18 Xclusive shocked #12 Team Barangay **8-0**. Xclusive took advantage of the erratic plays of their opponent in registering the win. Team Captain Albert Leyesa was on top with his 614 series with aid coming from Mel Aviles who controlled 588 series, Manny Lacuanan who organized 584 series, Boni Manalang who came in after with 541 and Lily Leyesa who came last with 538 series. Xclusive win allowed them to jump to #13 with their 40 points.
