V for Victory slowly working their way up coming as far as #20 in Round 4&5, moving to #18 in Round 6, to #17 in Round 7, moved back to #18 in Round 8, moved up to #15 in Round 9, went up further at #11 in Round 10, they finally entered the Elite Top 10 teams in Round 11 at #10, then moving to #8 in Round 12 before improving further to #7 by defeating Team Pilipinas in Round 13 of this thrilling action in Round 13 of the 51st DFBC All Filipino Bowling League, 2017 1st Conference supported by BEFIT-AKI Fitness.

Defending Champion and #8 V for Victory pounded #2 Team Pilipinas **7-2**. The team's hero Alfie de Ub ago carried the team to victory with his 641 series on games of 235, 202 & 204, Noel Bejar who powered his way to 622 series, Team Captain Butch Vargas who run around the defense of their opponent with 620 series, the handsome & debonair Myke Vargas inspiringly delivered 618 series and the in-love Rax Araneta who finished the scoring for her team with 588 series. V for Victory determined to defend the crown they won last conference now moved to #7 with 65 points.

Team Pilipinas was paced by Rey Castillo with 630 series, Ray Teodoro with 587 series, Team Captain Dennis Araza and Toto Agura with identical 572 series and Janet Jose with 541 series. Team Pilipinas slipped down to #4 with their total of 79 points.

#1 Covenant managed to survive the pesky #14 Sherlock **6-2**. Marlon Martinez keeping his composure led the team with 608 series. Dante's Peak victory pushed them up at #2 with 82 points.

Harimanok Farm was paced by Ruel Merina with 589, Tess Victoria with 578, Alvin Alfaro with 542 and Andy Erena with 536. Harimanok Farm continue to languish at the cellar with their 39 points.

#4 Ballantine's parading ADFBC 2017 1st Conference Master's Champions Gene Ornejas and Joylyn Sta. Barbara destroyed #16 D'Lucky Strikers **10-0**. With all bowlers fielded by Team Captain Mario Magdaluyo scoring above the 600 series it will be difficult to defeat this 5X Champions. Gene led all scorers with 652 series winning Ballantine's High Series of the Week award. Gene showing the stuff he is made of got ample support from Jay-R Yjares who dunked

620 series, the young RJ Calderon shattered with 617 series, Mario slammed 611 series and Joylyn Sta. Barbara smashed 610 series. Ballantine's win put them at #3 with 79 points.
