#4 Sherlock dominated #9 Derdan's Strikers 2017 **9-0** in this thrilling encounter in Round 6 of the 52nd DFBC All Filipino Bowling League, 2017 2nd Conference supported by BEFIT-AKI Fitness.

Stephen Fideles found his old touch back and what a way to recovered his shooting hands with a 704 series on games of 254, 241 & 209 winning Ballantine's High Series of the Week award. Sherlock was a well oiled machine in registering the win as aside from Stephen, 3 more bowlers scored above 600 series. Team Captain cum Manager Edgar Ramos played one of his best game so far with 656 series on games of 200, 208 & 248, his partner in crime Rodel "The Billionaire" Billones provided some spark with 618 scratch series with his 255 game in the second game allowed them to book their bonus point, the high flying Larry Dolor came high with 612 series and Tina Tabon relaxingly delivered 544 series the closed the game. Sherlock win put them on top of the standings with 41 points and allowed them to book their first DCC Cargo Team of the Week award with their total team series of 3,134 pin falls.

Derdan's Strikers 2017 was paced by Kim Co with 627 series, Aileen de Leon with 581 series, Team Captain Danilo Aquino with 577 series, Joel Umalsa with 535 series and Tony Jaro with 535 series. Derdan's Strikers 2017 fell down to #15 with 25 points.

#10 Team Pilipinas starring Mark Bumagat overwhelmed #2 Harimanok Farm **6-2**. Mark played like a man possessed as he piled strikes after strikes en route to his 278 scratch winning Dante's Peak Bowler of the Week award and the Accumulator Award. Mark led the team with his total of 686 scratch series. Mark was the lone bright spot for the team as the rest of struggles as they watched Mark in awe.
