

THE BOWLERS OF SYMMETRY (TBS) with all guns firing pulverized Team Barangay **12-0** in Round 8 of DFBC 52nd All Filipino Bowling League 2017, 2nd Conference Supported by BEFIT – AKI Fitness!!!

#1 The Bowlers of Symmetry (TBS) played like there is no tomorrow in decimating #11 Team Barangay **12-0** breaking few Team and individual records in this exciting Friday in Round 8 of the 52nd DFBC All Filipino Bowling League, 2017 2nd Conference supported by BEFIT-AKI Fitness.

The Bowlers of Symmetry (TBS) have monster games from 4 bowlers in establishing new Team Records led by Atty. Joe Rodrigo who was sizzling hot with 680 series on games of 228, 241 & 211. Atty. Joe received a lot of aid from the hard hitting Jonner Miranda who sizzles with a frightening 666 series, UAE reigning queen of bowling Uella Marcial who was scorching hot with 664 series on games of 208, 253 & 203, human beanpole Hilda Pilipina who crackles 632 series and Llave King Ryan Layoso who was almost there with 591 series. The Bowlers of Symmetry (TBS) broke Xclusive Team High Series Scratch of 2,872 with their 2,918 series, Xclusive Team High Series with Handicap of 3,232 with 3,233 series while Uella Marcial established a new High Game scratch with 249 and High Series Scratch with 652. TBS won DCC Cargo Team of the Week honors with their 3,233 pin falls and started to pull away from the pack as they increase their lead to double digit to 11 points with their total of 60 points.

Team Barangay was paced by Philip Cabutihan with 626, Arnold Asuncion with 597, Cherry Burayag with 571, Romie Alcantara with 551 and Team Captain Ariel Serrano (152) combined with Odie Burayag (418) for 570. Team Barangay went down to #14 with 35 points.

#9 Derdan's Strikers 2017 showing maturity massacred #13 Wild Wild X **11-0**. With all bowlers scoring above 600 series, there is no way Wild Wild X will be able to beat this team. It was former MMA fighter Kelly Odiong carrying the load for The Strikers with 674 series as he kicked and punched his way thru the defenses of Wild Wild X. Kelly received ample support from Joel Umalsa who stood tall finishing with 654 series, Tony Jaro who forced his way to 648 series on games of 219, 201 & 228, the ageless warrior Fuly Sales Primo came prepared bashed 626 series and Team Captain Danilo Aquino put on the finishing touches with 603 series. Derdan's Strikers 2017 moved up to #6 with 46 points.

Wild Wild X was paced by Rodel Calderon with 613 series, Team Captain Sonny Cosio with 559 series, Mariza Santiago with 556 series, Obet Lucero with 547 series and Ron with 475 series. Wild Wild X is at #16 with 32 points.

#7 Tweeners took turns in beating the lights out of cellar dweller Friendly Bowlers in carving out a **9-0** win. Tess Victoria was the star for the team with 643 series on games of 226, 204 & 213. Tess got a lot of help from Doc Ronnie Fabian who slowly getting his rhythm back with 608 series, Robi "Patira" Gamboa who smacked 607 series, Team Captain Kathleen Raymundo who smashed 564 series and The Black Superman, Xanthie "Doc" Fronda who flew with 551 series. Tweeners win put them at #3 with 48 points.

Friendly Bowlers was paced by Andy Matic with 610 series, Ging Aring with 597 series, Grace Abalos with 593 series, Gary Faustino with 504 series and Mythet Conejero with 441 series. Friendly Bowlers stayed at #13 with 13 points.

#8 Xclusive managed to conquer #17 IIEE **8-3**. It was the young and the restless J Glen Leyesa who exploded for 694 series highlighted by his 285 in the 3rd game winning both Ballantine's High Series of the Week and Dante's Peak Bowler of the Week award. J Glen was the recipient of aid from The Brown Adonis, Boni Manalang who castigated 628 series, Team Captain and Dad Albert Leyesa who criticized

with 599 series, Mom Lily Leyesa who chastised with 587 series and Manny Lacuanan who finished 538 series. Xclusive win pushed them up to #5 with 46 points.

IIEE was paced by Arnel Arias with 644, Christine Ocampo with 603, Bernard Solomon with 579, Isagani Porcina with 573 and Joven with 555. IIEE is at #17 with 26 points.

#15 Approach-A-Bowls blanked #18 B&G **8-0**. It was the hulking Ato Lubao who led the team with 631 series. Ato received a lot of support from Daisy Rivera who shot 623 series, the small but lovely Marivic Parducho who shoot 591 series, Joel Pangan who fired 553 series and Albert Soriano who banged 547 series. Approach-A-Bowls moved to #11 with 37 points.

B&G was paced by Edwin Diaz (617), Babes Lopez (607), Dong Corpuz (542), Team Captain Herbert Capili (531) and Ford Deriquito (369) joined hands with Maria Macatangay (188) for 557. B&G stayed at #18 with 23 points.

Team Pilipinas was paced by Caloy Serrano with 619, Mark Bumagat with 599 scratch, Team Captain Dennis Araza with 580, Sheila Estabaya with 563 and Janet Jose with 518. Team Pilipinas is at #12 with 36 points.

#14 Ballantine's recorded their 3rd consecutive win at the expense of #5 DCC Cargo **6-3**. The team was directed by Marivic Alfaro who top scored for 667 series winning Ballantine's High Series of the Week award. Marivic was complimented by Ricky Reyes who contributed 590 scratch series, The Original Pasaway Jay-R Yjares who added 589 series, RJ Calderon who amassed 560 series and Team Captain Mario Magdaluyo who end the scoring with 503 series. Ballantine's moved up to #13 with 35 points.

DCC Cargo was paced by Merle Pilapil Cada with 639 series on games of 227, 204 & 208, Danny Casio with 578, Bing Castaneda with 576, Team Captain Tracyval Cada with 563 and Arnel Bermas with 500. DCC Cargo fell to #9 with 44 points.

#10 FC Bowlers defeated #4 Covenant **6-2**. Reb Esmá spearheaded the attack of FC's as he led with 651 series. Reb got ample help from Chris Calgao who was also sizzling with 647 series, Cris Toledo who recorded 578 series, Ronald Valdez who responded with 557 series and Jomar Naguit (327) joined hands with Team Captain Noel Benavidez (164) for 491 series. FC Bowlers moved to #10 with 41 points.

Covenant was paced by Team Captain Maria Gil with 582, Jojo Acebron with 568, Hector Francia with 542, Danton Abejero with 539 and Maureen Dujali (179) bolted with Marissa Manalo (390) for 569. Covenant is at #8 with 44 points.
